As I went over the homepage, I took note of any words or phrases that were repeated several times throughout and deleted the repeats, while ensuring the information was still being told somewhere else on the homepage. I began heavily editing by deleting any out-of-date events that was being advertised and took out any irrelevant information such as telling the viewer that the company participates in an event instead of describing what that event is and how and why it is important. To avoid taking out more large chunks of information and losing the meaning, I went through each section and made tweaks to some of the wording in the remaining sentences. I began with 332 words on the homepage and finished with 182 words. While not exactly half, I feel this amount cuts back on the word count, making it more concise and still retaining the message GRK is trying to convey.
